The 'wav' file is an audio file. It can be played upon a computer and fed from an audio port into a cassette adaptor, such as the one below, which can be inserted into the cassette unit of a Sharp MZ80K computer.

The program runs under Sharp Basic on the MZ80k.

The use of a cassette adaptor can be tricky because the audio wire can get in the way of shutting the cassette unit, but I have managed to make this arrangement work.
